

# One More, One Less

**Printing Tip:** Print pages 2 and 3 back to back so the rules of the game are printed on the back and can be easily referred to if needed.

# One More, One Less

## How do you play?

Each player gets counters that are all the same colour. If 1 player has picked blue counters the other player(s) must choose a different colour.

Players take turns to roll a 6 sided dice. Players choose to add 1 to the rolled number or take away 1 from the rolled number. The player then puts a counters on one of the spots on the board.

The player with the most counters on the board at the end of the game is the winner.

# One More, One Less

A large honeycomb grid of hexagons containing numbers. The numbers are arranged in a roughly rectangular shape. The numbers are: 7, 4, 6, 2, 3, 2, 4, 7, 1, 5, 0, 3, 2, 3, 5, 2, 1, 6, 3, 4, 7, 4, 5, 5, 1, 0, 1, 7, 4, 5, 4, 3, 7, 5, 5, 0, 3, 6, 5.

There are five bees scattered around the grid: one at the top left, one at the top right, one on the left side, one at the bottom left, and one on the right side.
