

Print page 2 and 3 back-to-back making the rules of the game on the back of the board for quick reference.

What You Need

- o 3 dice
- A game board numbered
- Recording sheet (page 3)
- Counters or small tokens for each player

How to Play

- 1. Roll the Dice: Roll all three dice.
- 2. Form a Number Sentence: Use any combination of the operations—addition, subtraction, multiplication, or division—and all three dice to create a number sentence that equals 1.
- 3. Can't Make 1?: If you can't make 1, the other player rolls the dice and tries to form a number sentence that equals 1.
- **4.** Place a Counter: If you successfully make 1, place a counter on top of the number 1 on your game board. Recode the equation on the recording sheet (page 3)
- 5. Make the next number: Without rolling the dice again, try to create the next number, 2.
- 6. Continue the Challenge: Keep taking turns, moving around the game board from 1 to 8. Your turn ends when you can't create the next number with the dice you rolled.
- 7. Winning the Game: The player who places counters on the most numbers wins!

Alternative Ways to Play

- Choose Your Dice: Use only two of the three dice you rolled.
- o Solo Play: Each player has their own game board to travel around.
- o Flexible Order: Place counters on numbers in any order instead of moving from 1 to 8.
- Extended Range: Use 10-sided dice or spinners to make the equations.
