Nouns name a person, place, thing, idea, animal, quality or activity

Proper Nouns name specific things, people and places. They need a capital letter.

Common Nouns name general things. They don't need a capital letter. Common Nouns include:

- **Concrete Nouns** which name things you can touch, taste, see, hear or smell
pencil hat bang scent
- **Abstract Nouns** name qualities or ideas
love justice
- **Collective Nouns** are names for groups of people or things
A flock of sheep A group of children

Pronouns are words used in place of specific nouns.

Lucinda was excited **she** was going to the show.

They thought the ball was **mine**.

You are very kind to **him**.
