Common Nouns name general things. They don't need a capital letter. Common Nouns include:

- Concrete Nouns which name things you can touch, taste, see, hear or smell pencil hat bang scent
- Abstract Nouns name qualities or ideas love justice
- Collective Nouns are names for groups of people or things

A <u>flock</u> of sheep A <u>group</u> of children

Pronouns are words used in place of specific nouns.

Lucinda was excited she was going to the show.

They thought the ball was mine.

You are very kind to him.
